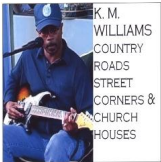

The Texas Country Blues Preacher; K. M. Williams; known for reproducing the songs and sounds of early 20th Century Texas/Mississippi Delta Country Blues, Boogies and Spirituals of Lightning Hopkins, John Lee Hooker & Blind Willie Johnson, has, this time around, reaches both back in the past, playing some tracks in the old Texas acoustic blues styles (even one track with a Diddley Bow) but takes some steps into the future by adding some modern drum mixes; The Hard Rocking Electric Mississippi Blues sounds of RL Burnside, T-Model Ford and Jesse Mae Hemphill; The Distorted Slide Chicago Blues of Hound Dog Taylor and the Hard Rock Guitars Sounds of Jimi Hendrix to create a different kind of Country Blues. This CD will appeal to both the Blues Purist, Modern Blues fan and even Classic Rock & Gospel fans alike by an ingenious mixing of the Traditional with the Contemporary to make some groundbreaking Texas/Mississippi Country Blues/Boogie music - A Fan.
