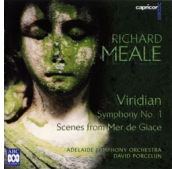

Australia's greatest modern composer, Richard Meale, is one of the more melodic of contemporary composers. Forsaking his avant garde roots, Meale produced the superb Symphony No 1 in 1994 which is expertly played here by The Adelaide Symphony Orchestra conducted by David Porcelijn. The one movement piece bristles with invention over its 23 minute course as with the other works included here "Viridian" and "Scenes from Mer de Grace". Modern Classical music is NOT all Boulez, check out the melodic genius of Richard Meale for proof. --- rateyourmusic.com
