It's rather amazing today, when recordings of Bach's Well-Tempered Clavier practically fall off the shelves, to recall just how unusual it was back in the 1960s for a pianist to undertake to record this amazing work. What Gould proves in this essential set is that Bach is decidedly not just a threat to hold over the head of budding pianists but a joy to listen to.
