The Spanish songs recital was recorded in the late 70's with conductor Robin Stapleton (I believe). Carreras's voice back then was a true marvel - honeyed and powerful at the same time. While the title is misleading (Mattinata, if memory serves, was never a Spanish song) this CD contains many beloved classics, such as Solamente Una Vez (sometimes performed in English as "you belong to my heart"), tango El Dia Que Me Quieras, thunderous Amapola, and more. Most songs are performed like opera arias - meaning larger-than-life treatment, except, perhaps, Quireme Mucho, which is a lovely lower-key song that allows Carreras to take advantage of his burnished lower register.
