Conversation is likely to stop if you put on the CD reissue of "O Holy Night" featuring Luciano Pavarotti with the National Philharmonic Orchestra under Kurt Herbert Adler with the Wandsworth Boys' Choir and the London Voices... Most of the music, an indiscriminating patchwork of Catholic religiosity from Schubert through Franck to Bach/Gounod, has been re-arranged, but Yon's *Gesu bambino* and the *Sanctus* from the Berlioz *Requiem* are left with their original orchestration. *Adeste fideles* at the end is dominated by that breathtaking swooping voice. ----Gramophone [12/1985]
