Misia is a Portuguese fado singer, born in 1955 in Porto, Portugal. Misia is a polyglot. Despite singing mostly fado, she sings some of her themes in Spanish, French, Catalan, English and even Japanese. Misia depicts herself as a cabaret dancer living in the "Drama Box Hotel" with her musicians.

Throughout her career, Misia developed a new style: she modernized Amália Rodrigues's fado, shocking orthodox audiences by adding to the traditional instruments (bass guitar, classical guitar and Portuguese guitar) the sensuality of the accordion and the violin, and borrowing their finest verses from the greatest Portuguese poets.
